MYM Daycare Rules & Procedures

1. Drop-Off & Pick-Up Hours. Drop-Off and Pick-Up hours are maintained to minimize barking and disruptions to play. And the more calm, quiet and matter of fact you are about dropping them off and picking them up, the easier it is for your dog (and the dogs already here). Please arrive between 7am-9am. Pick-Up is between 4pm-6pm. If you experience an unforeseen delay please call 360-693-4503 to notify the daycare attendant ASAP.

2. Vaccinations. When your dog receives vaccinations please plan for 2 days between vaccination date and next daycare attendance.

3. First Day Jitters. If daycare is a new experience for you, you may worry if your dog will miss you too much, "What if MY dog is a bully on the playground?", etc. When you are nervous it is possible to project your tension onto your dog. Do tell us if you are nervous, and feel free to ask questions. But don't let on to your dog! Don't baby-talk, don't make a fuss and don't linger or peer in the window. Having you just out of reach in the foyer or at the window can be very difficult for some dogs and often they won't join the play until they are no longer focusing on you. The more calm, quiet and matter of fact you are about dropping them off and picking them up, the easier it is for your dog (and the dogs already here). And remember, you are always welcome to call and check in for a progress report.

4. Payment. Payment is due at the end of each daycare day or for your convenience, prepaid punch cards are also offered at a discounted rate.

5. Reservations & Cancellations. Our maximum daily playgroup size is based on knowing who is and isn't coming. Advanced reservations are highly recommended and without a confirmed reservation your dog may be turned away. Please try give 24+ hours notice for cancellations, no-shows may be charged the missed day.

Drop-Off Procedure

1. Step into the large intake pen with your dog and close the gate behind you.
2. Remove all gear from your dog including collar. You may take it with you or hang it on the provided hooks.
3. The daycare attendant will open the secondary gates to let your dog in when everyone is ready.

Pick-Up Procedure

1. If payment is due, and you need to pay with credit/debit card, please do so before gathering your dog
2. Step into the large intake pen and close the gate behind you.
3. The daycare attendant will open the secondary gates to release your dog to you when everyone is ready.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: May I stay and watch my dog play?

A: The answer is highly variable depending on your dog, the current playgroup, etc. Feel free to ask, but sometimes it isn't feasible.

Q: What about gratuity?

A: Tipping is not an industry standard and is not expected. We do appreciate being appreciated, but "thanks" and smiles is enough. And referring us to others and posting positive reviews online is the very best way of all to thank us!

Q: My dog was kicked out of another daycare, can they come to yours?

A: Please discuss the details with us. Even if your dog was implicated as the instigator in one situation and playgroup they may still fit in well here. We do not have any automatic exclusions based on preconceived notions. But on the flip side, not all dogs are a good fit for a playcare daycare setting. If that's the case, we'd be happy to discuss other options that may be a better solution.

Q: Will my dog be crated/penned up?

A: If you send lunch with your dog, they will be allowed to eat in peace and privacy in a crate so they don't have to deal with other dogs expecting them to share! Some dogs that have otherwise great dog social skills get too excited at the gate and are crated during drop-off or pick-up. Unless they otherwise show the need for a quiet time or more nap than they are able to get in the playroom, they are not crated/penned up at all through the day.
